

While we need technology to advance civilization, some people misuse the neutral nature of technology to hurt other people for individual gains. How to stop those people? Nature provides the hints. This article attempts to reveal how Nature works and what it teaches us.

Revelation 3. There is a book called "iching" which was started 6000 years ago in sketches. It was turned into writing and polished over the next 3500
